Spanish Colonial Revival architecture shares some elements with the earlier Mission Revival style derived from the architecture of the California missions, and Pueblo Revival style from the traditional Puebloan peoples in New Mexico. Both precedents were popularized in the Western United States by the Fred Harvey and his Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Depots and Hotels. Spain - History: Human fossils in Spain belong to modern humans (*Homo sapiens*), the Neanderthals (*H. neanderthalensis*), and even earlier members of the human lineage, possibly *H. erectus* or *H. heidelbergensis*. A large number of bones have been recovered from caves at Atapuerca, Burgos, which come from sediments that are at least 300,000 years old.
