For example, applicants in the state of New York must face one of the most rigorous Notary tests in the U.S., the NY Notary Public License Exam. First-time applicants must pass a written and proctored exam which is administered at various locations throughout the state. person appointed as notary public must, at the time of his or her appointment, be a citizen of the United States and either a resident of the State of New York or have an office or place of business in New York State. A notary public who is a resident of the State and who moves out of What exam would a practicing attorney in New York be required to take to serve as a notary? Attorneys who are admitted to the NYS Bar and are practicing in New York State are not required to sit for the Notary Public Exam - they must, however, submit an application and pay the mandatory fee. An applicant for a notary public commission must submit to the Division of Licensing Services an original application and \$60 fee. The application includes an oath of office, which must be sworn and notarized. In addition to the application form and fee, the applicant must have taken and passed the notary public examination.
